


## With the right support, people can change:

## We deliver services on behalf of local authorities:

WDP started off as a little community centre in Westminster,

hence the name. Today we have 22 centres across
London the South East and the East of England. We deliver services on behalf of local authorities, commissioned by the Drug & Alcohol Teams. Most of our income is earned from delivering services to people affected by drug and alcohol problems in local communities.





The Recovery Centre, WDP Barnet is a support service for individuals who are affected by drug and alcohol problems.

We have a dedicated team of substance misuse practitioners who work alongside other professionals including doctors, nurses, psychologists and therapists in the London Borough of Barnet.

We offer a high quality and professional service providing a range of support to individuals who wish to receive advice, assessment and treatment for their drug and alcohol problems.

We work very closely with the **Barnet Service User Group** (**BSUG**) whose aim is to help Service Users to have a voice about their treatment plans and a say in the way the service is delivered.

Our service includes criminal justice services, structured day programme, aftercare and the peer support groups (Pg. 7).
